What is an Acrostic Poem?

An acrostic poem is a poem in which the first letter of each line spells out a word, name, or phrase when read vertically.

Example of an acrostic poem

Lewis Carroll, 'A Boat Beneath a Sunny Sky' (excerpt)

A boat beneath a sunny sky,
Lingering onward dreamily
In an evening of July —

Children three that nestle near,
Eager eye and willing ear...

This first part of the Carroll poem spells
ALICE.
